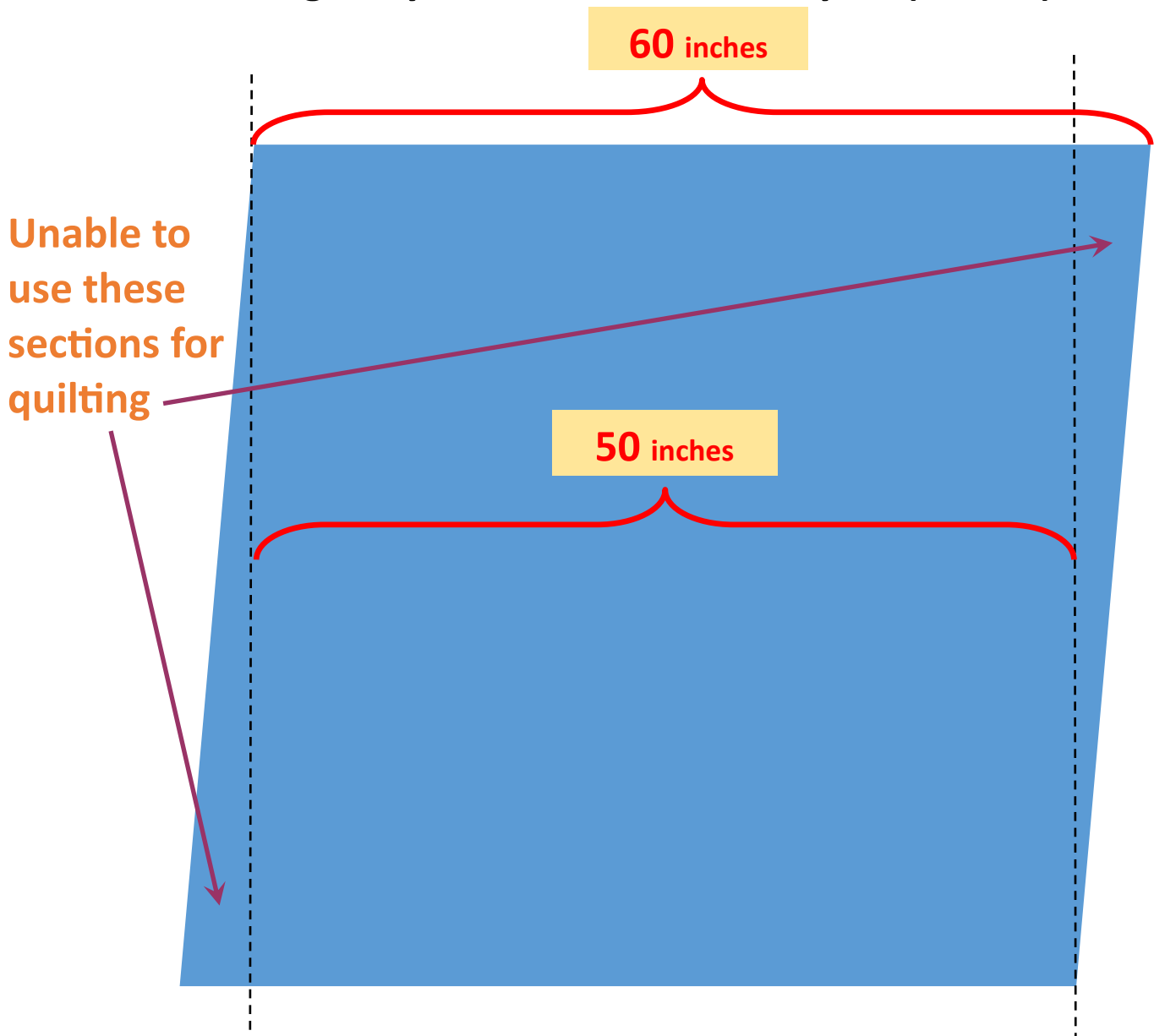


## Diagram of quilt backing that is not square (parallelogram)

Note: 10 total inches are lost on the sides

What was originally 60 inches are actually 50 (usable) inches



- Backing should be “square” and have 90 degree angles on all four corners.
- If you choose to use a sheet for your backing fabric, remove (cut off) all four finished (folded) edges. Measure again to ensure sheet is large enough.
- Backing (and batting) **must be at least 8” - 10” wider and longer** than the quilt top measurements.
